PSC to Begin Hearings on Georgia Power Company's Twelfth Plant Vogtle Construction Monitoring Report on June 2, 2015

Atlanta, May 28, 2015 – The Georgia Public Service Commission (Commission) will begin hearings on Tuesday June 2, 2015 on the Georgia Power Company's Twelfth Plant Vogtle Construction Monitoring (VCM) Report in Docket 29849. The hearing will start immediately following the regularly scheduled 10 a.m. Administrative Session in Room 110 at the Commission offices at 244 Washington Street, S.W. Atlanta, Georgia 30334.

The Commission will begin by hearing from any public witnesses pursuant to O.C.G.A. §46-2-59(g). Immediately following public witnesses, the Commission will hear preliminary matters and then conduct a hearing on the direct case of Georgia Power Company (Company).

The schedule in this docket is as follows:

June 2, 2015	Georgia Power Company presents direct testimony
June 10, 2015	Staff and intervenors file direct testimony
June 23, 2015	Staff and intervenors present testimony
July 10, 2015	Georgia Power Company files rebuttal testimony
July 23, 2015	Georgia Power Company presents rebuttal testimony
August 7, 2015	Parties file briefs and/or proposed orders
August 18, 2015	Commission issues decision at Administrative Session

Under Georgia law, within 180 days of the Company's filing of the 12th VCM progress report, the Commission shall verify and approve or disapprove expenditures made pursuant to the certificate. According to the statute, if the Commission fails to so act within 180 days after such filing, the expenditures shall be deemed approved by operation of law. The statutory deadline in this Docket is August 26, 2015. O.C.G.A. § 46-3A-7(b)
