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Governed by 2 rules:

Staff was ordered to facilitate a Demand Side Management Working Group and initiate the process required for amending the Commission's existing rules *

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Working Group Directives:

- ❑ Present the Commission a mix of DSM initiatives (with supporting details) for approval*
- ❑ Recommend a process for the selection of DSM initiatives in the future.

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4 Initiatives Adopted

- ❑ **Energy Star Home Program**
 - ❑ **Energy Star Appliance Program**
 - ❑ **Duct Sealing & Infiltration Control Program**
 - ❑ **Home Inspector Pilot Program**
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(From the Report) “Utilities filing IRPs will meet with interested stakeholders at least three times...to solicit input...”

- **Approximately 18 months before the official IRP filing date for input on measures and programs that should be included...(July 22, 2005)**
- Approximately 12 months before the official IRP filing date to review cost effectiveness screening of DSM measures...
- Approximately 6 months before the official IRP filing date to review cost effectiveness screening of DSM programs...

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Remaining Steps

- Complete Economic Screening of Measures
 - End of 2005 (*CURRENTLY*)
 - Working Group to review results when complete.

- Demand-Side Program Development (Mid-2006).
 - Working Group to again review results.

- 2007 IRP Filing
 - Early 2007
