Georgia Territorial Electric Service Act

O.C.G.A. § 46-3-2

March 1973, the legislature drafted this law to create a plan whereby every geographic area within the state shall be either assigned to an electric supplier or declared unassigned as to any electric supplier

The reasons cited for doing so were:

- ❑ To assure for the most efficient, economical, & orderly rendering of retail service
- ❑ To inhibit duplication of the lines of suppliers
- ❑ To foster the extension & location of lines in the manner that allows for the preservation & enhancement of the state's physical environment
- ❑ To protect and conserve lines lawfully constructed by electric suppliers
