**PIPELINE SAFETY INSPECTOR**

Annual Salary: Commensurate with Experience and Education

Duties and Responsibilities: Under general supervision, performs safety investigations, evaluations and analysis of specialized areas of all natural gas utility operators of distribution, transmission and LNG (liquefied natural gas) systems in Georgia. Performs investigative techniques beyond the normal scope to determine issues of considerable complexity and sensitivity in natural gas accident investigations for assigned areas. Assists in safety training for operators and the industry concerning natural gas pipeline systems. Responsible for evaluation of natural gas utilities in determining operator compliance with applicable state and federal safety regulation.

Preferred Education: Degree from 2- or 4-year Accredited College/Technical College

or

Minimum Training and Experience: Two years at journey level in the construction, maintenance or repair of gas pipeline systems. Good knowledge of the construction, maintenance, testing or repair of gas distribution systems. Working skill in keeping accurate records and in writing concise reports for natural gas operator inspections. Working ability to read and comprehend technical regulations. Working ability to judge the quality of welds and pipe construction. Good knowledge of and working ability in using a computer/cell phone/tablet/etc.

Required Travel: Initial Inspector training is required and involves several weeks of out-of-state travel over a 3-year period. Local and statewide travel is required weekly.

Exam and Evaluation Information: Evaluation of credentials and experience.

Additional Information: All new hires subject to a background check, and this position will include random drug testing. Submit an application package with Letter of Interest, Resume, Commission Application, State Application, and School Transcripts.
