Duties and Responsibilities:

Under general supervision, performs work of considerable difficulty in the analysis and evaluation of electric utility issues including: revenue requirement and rate design, integrated resource planning - supply and demand side, energy efficiency/renewable energy, fuel cost recovery, construction monitoring, reliability, environmental using electric utility regulatory accounting, finance and economics; typically serves as a technical expert on financial analysis methods, procedures and statistical analysis. Handles multiple projects efficiently (within specific and/or short deadlines). Serves as a member or leader on docketed and non-docketed matters on advocate or advisory team. May serve as an expert witness. Assists in establishing, reviewing, maintaining and administering Commission Rules and Regulations necessary for the regulation of utilities as prescribed by Georgia Law and Public Service Commission Policy and Orders. Assists in developing computerized databases of industry and company specific performance and statistical data. Serves as member of the Electric Strategic Planning Team.

<u>Minimum Training, Experience Skills and Abilities</u>: Completion of a bachelor's degree in accounting, finance, economics, engineering or related field from an accredited four-year college or university. In addition, completion of a graduate degree in accounting, finance, economics or related field, or 3 or more years professional work experience in utility regulatory ratemaking, accounting, finance or economics. Good oral and written communication skills.

<u>Preferred Qualifications</u>: One or more of the following: Completion of a graduate degree in accounting, finance or economics; 5 or more years professional work experience in utility regulatory ratemaking, accounting or economics; certification as a CPA; experience in presenting expert testimony in regulatory proceedings.
